Event title	Week of children safety in traffic
Event description:	

On September 5th, 2024, an important event aimed at promoting children's safety in traffic was held at the Faculty of Technical Sciences, University of Priština, located in Kosovska Mitrovica. Organized in cooperation with the Red Cross of Kosovska Mitrovica and the Technical High School "Mihajlo Petrović Alas," the event featured practical simulations and educational sessions focusing on traffic safety, particularly for children.

The Red Cross of Kosovska Mitrovica took the lead in simulating various traffic scenarios, demonstrating how to react in case of accidents, and providing guidance on helping injured civilians. This hands-on approach was designed to educate both children and adults on essential first-aid techniques and how to stay safe in traffic.

The significance of the event was further emphasized by **doc. dr Aleksandra Petrović**, a representative from the Faculty of Technical Sciences, who spoke about the growing need for awareness regarding traffic safety, especially where children are concerned. She highlighted that traffic incidents involving children can have devastating consequences and stressed the importance of proper education and vigilance in preventing such accidents.

In addition to addressing traffic safety, doc. dr Petrović took the opportunity to promote the **Erasmus+ SPHERE project**, which focuses on enhancing education and safety measures within the local community and beyond. The SPHERE project aims to improve traffic safety awareness and foster cooperation between educational institutions, organizations, and local authorities.

The event successfully combined practical training, education, and the promotion of collaborative projects to ensure that traffic safety remains a priority, especially for the youngest members of the community. By bringing together students, educators, and local organizations, it reinforced the message that safeguarding children in traffic is a collective responsibility.
