As part of ongoing efforts to foster academic collaboration and promote Erasmus+ projects, on April, 2nd a delegation from the Faculty of Transport and Traffic Engineering, Doboj – University of East Sarajevo, visited the Faculty of Technical Sciences in Kosovska Mitrovica, University of Priština, currently seated in Kosovska Mitrovica (UPKM). This significant event marked a new chapter in regional cooperation in higher education.

The visit served as an opportunity to exchange experiences, explore joint academic interests, and formalize the collaboration between the two institutions. One of the key outcomes of the visit was the signing of a Memorandum of Cooperation, establishing a formal framework for future joint activities in education, research, and international projects.
