Event title	Workshop on Writing Erasmus+ Projects at the University of Mitrovica
Event description:	

On September 23, 2025, a workshop dedicated to the preparation and writing of Erasmus+ project proposals was held at the Faculty of Technical Sciences in Kosovska Mitrovica. The event gathered representatives from all faculties of the University of Priština in Kosovska Mitrovica, emphasizing the importance of active participation in international cooperation programs and strengthening institutional capacities for project development.

The attendees were welcomed by doc. dr Aleksandra Petrović and prof. dr Siniša Ilić, who underlined the importance of continuous training and international networking within the Erasmus+ framework. Goran Lazić, representative of the Erasmus+ office in North Mitrovica, also addressed the participants, highlighting the key opportunities that the program provides for universities in the Western Balkans. In addition, Miloš Subotić, representative of the University's Rectorate and an experienced project manager, shared valuable insights from practice and spoke about the significance of strategic planning and interfaculty cooperation in developing successful Erasmus+ project proposals.

During the workshop, participants had the opportunity to exchange experiences, learn about current Erasmus+ priorities, and gain practical knowledge related to project formulation, application, and implementation. Special attention was given to the presentation of several ongoing Erasmus+ projects in which the University is already involved, one of them being SPHERE — which serves as examples of successful regional and international collaboration.

The event once again demonstrated the University's commitment to enhancing international visibility and fostering cooperation within the Western Balkans and the European Higher Education Area
